

NAVAIR JOURNEY LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM EXECUTIVE CORE QUALIFICATIONS WORKSHOP

The NAVAIR Journey Leadership Development Program (JLDP) is a one to two year program designed for NAVAIR journey-level military and civilian employees who have demonstrated leadership potential. The program features the following:

- Classroom-based leadership training and mentoring
- Senior leader interview
- Three shadowing assignments
- Wellness-related activities
- Participation in leadership/diversity events

JLDP is open to the following ranks/grades:

- GS9 – 13
- WG9 – 13 or equivalent bands
- Salary equivalent to GS 09/4 to less than GS14/4
- E-4 through E-6
- O-1 to O-3

A National Executive Core Qualification Workshop is scheduled to assist interested individuals with the application process. The JLDP application is open from 26 January through 1 March 2016.
