

## CISL-CYB-100 INTRODUCTION TO CYBER WARFARE

This unclassified course will introduce students to cyber warfare definitions, types of cyber-attacks, tools, countermeasures, and best practices used to detect, deter, and defend against cyber-incidents, as well as current threats to operations and assets, individuals, and the nation. Increased awareness of the need to design and employ effective risk-based processes and technologies will help ensure that all NAVAIR's information systems and the Navy's aviation weapons systems (business and platform IT) have the necessary resilience built in to support ongoing capabilities to the warfighter and enforce national security policies.
