PROBLEM:

Authorize and distribute the Table of Basic Allowances (TBA).

DISCUSSION:

The Mobile Facilities (MF) Workload Planning is utilizing a "new" TBA that reflects certain MF footprint reductions that the current (1994) TBA does not reflect. Fleet units are being required to construct CSP's and meet rework and workload requirements of a TBA that is not authorized and in print. This creates great difficulty in managing a MALSP concept to meet force readiness.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize and distribute the TBA in full working format to include breakdowns for CSP's, Work Centers (W/C), Configuration Codes, and Ancillary Equipment. This would promote better cohesion between the workload requirements and Fleet MALSP reporting demands.
