PROBLEM:

CASS TPS (MF)'S

DISCUSSION:

It is generally agreed that, as CASS replaces the legacy systems (I.E. HTS, RSTS, ETC.), existing TPS support (MFs) will be retained by units. The current TBA does not support this plan. There are also units scheduled to receive CASS MFs that do not currently have these legacy systems in their inventory. A plan should be formalized to ensure these MFs are retained and redistributed as required to provide sufficient coverage throughout the fleet.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Realign TBA to reflect this MF retainment plan.
2. Identify need and formalize a distribution plan as required.
