PROBLEM: Marines assigned to work center 990 are a combination of different Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) FAP'd from various divisions and work centers. Generally they lack knowledge of daily work activities experienced in the Mobile Facility (MF) community. Maintenance and repair of generators, environmental control units, electrical wiring, and MF lighting takes several months to become competent and proficient. On the other hand, Marines functioning outside their work center for a year usually return to their assigned MOS having lost valuable knowledge and expertise in their original MOS placing these Marines well behind their peers in their technical development.

RECOMMENDATION: Recommended that the Mobile Facilities Work Center 990 create its own MOS skill designator and fill billets according to current requirements, or assign Marines in MOS 6072 and 6073 to W/C 990 exclusively, since they are already trained in the requisite knowledge and skills to perform this maintenance.
