PROBLEM	Originator unable to find any training courses for MF complexing, site surveys, electrical load calculations, etc. necessary to train for MF redeployment. Information contained in the MF ULSS and in the most recent newsletter (31 March 1998) identifies a two-week course C-602-3310 as “MF Repair and Complexing”. Per NAMTRAU NORIS, the entire course was cut to one week and teaches only MF corrosion control.
RECOMMENDATION	Identify training sites and courses which teach generic MF complexing principles to include site survey, layout, regulations, electrical load calculations, power distribution, etc. Provide a link from the MF website sidebar for MF TRAINING and provide current training course information.
