 - HQMC now has ownership and control of the TBA. The TBA report will have to be reviewed annually.

 - Presented evaluations on Aviation Logistic Support Ship T-AVB and BOH containers.
- **Jamie McDonald/BAE SYSTEMS:**
 - Gave a general overview of MFTool and went over new changes. Will go live 1 July 08. MFTool will be in an on-going phase for at least a year.
 - PO will send message requesting update on certain reports by a certain date.
 - Fleet will not send reports; fleet will update database and PO will extract information needed.

 - First of two final KA-18A designs have been delivered to MALS-14 and explained new changes.
 - Developing MF design to replace KA-10B.
 - Tentative plan is to change KA-09A into KA-19A and KA-10B into KA-20B.
 - Will hold excess KA-14 vans for future FW TBA or Air Force requirements.

 - Discussion on MF Wash Policy. Program has found this is a huge area of neglect. Want to issue a message on wash policy. PO will establish procedures on MRC cards.
