11j: While performing aboard NAVAIR sites, the contractor shall comply with the provisions of OPNAVINST 3432.1 and the local command 3432 instruction series for Operations Security; and Program Specific Program Protection Plan (PPP) for the protection of the Critical Program Information (CPI) identified in the Programs' PPP. At all other NAVAIR and Field Activities the contractor shall comply with the local command and/or Program OPSEC Plan and/or Program Protection Plan (PPP).
