Item 11 j – OPSEC: The contractor shall develop, implement and maintain a facility level OPSEC Program to protect critical information to be used at the contractor facility during the performance of this contract. Contractor shall submit OPSEC Plan to: Commander, Naval Air Systems Command, ATTN: PMA-265 Security Manager, 47123 Buse Road, Bldg 2272, Ste 445, Patuxent River, MD 20670. While performing aboard NAVAIR sites, the contractor shall comply with the provisions of NAWCADINST 3432.1A; at all other sites the contractor shall comply with the local command and/or program OPSEC plan. If additional guidance is required, contact AIR-7.4.3 at (301)757-7516.

Contract is for equipment maintenance services on equipment which processes classified information. Actual knowledge of, generation, or production of classified information is not required for performance of the contract. Cleared personnel are required to perform this service because access to classified information cannot be precluded by escorting personnel. Any classification guidance needed will be provided by the using activity.

Contract performance is restricted to Kuwait. The COR will provide security classification guidance for performance of this contract. No documents/material may be released to Kuwait government unless previously authorized release under this contract.

The following conditions apply to classified tasks in overseas locations:

1. Confidential Clearance Level

The Contractor's representative must have at least a U.S. Confidential Clearance, or a Interim U.S. Secret Clearance prior to reporting to the task site. No direct charges (man day rates or associated travel expenses) will be allowable if the Contractor's representative shows up at a task site without the specified security clearance or if interim or final clearance is suspended, denied, withdrawn, or revoked.

Contractor personnel will report to the cognizant field officer in charge for a security briefing prior to reporting to their task assignment. Prior to vacating their assigned task, all contractor personnel shall report to the field officer in charge to be debriefed and return all Government issued credentials and any classified material in their possession.


