CMDCM (AW/IW) Augustine Mark Command Master Chief

Master Chief Augustine Mark assumed the duties as the Commander Fleet Readiness Centers Command Master Chief in October 2017. His previous command tours were Fleet Readiness Center Mid-Atlantic, Virginia Beach, Virginia, Naval Computer and Telecommunications Station Far East, Yokosuka, Japan and Strike Fighter Squadron THREE ONE (VFA-31), Virginia Beach, Virginia.

A native of the Spice Island Grenada in the Eastern Caribbean, he grew up in Brooklyn, New York where he attended and graduated from Boys and Girls High School. He joined the U.S. Navy in August 1988.

After completing basic training in Great Lakes, Illinois, he reported to AMH "A" School in Millington, Tennessee in October 1998. His first duty assignment was on shore with Strike Fighter Squadron ONE ZERO SIX (VFA-106) in Jacksonville, Florida. Other shore duty assignments include Fleet Air Reconnaissance Squadron TWO (VQ-2), Rota, Spain and Naval Air Technical Data and Engineering Service Command (NATEC) Detachment New River, Jacksonville, North Carolina.



Master Chief Mark's Sea Tours include Strike Fighter Squadron ONE NINE FIVE (VFA-195), Atsugi, Japan, Strike Fighter Squadron EIGHT TWO (VFA-82), Jacksonville, Florida, Strike Fighter Squadron TWO SEVEN (VFA-27), Atsugi, Japan and Strike Fighter Squadron ONE NINE TWO (VFA-192), Atsugi, Japan. He has deployed onboard carriers USS INDEPENDENCE (CV 62), USS AMERICA (CV 66), USS GEORGE WASHINGTON (CVN 73), USS KITTY HAWK (CV 63) and USS GEORGE H.W. BUSH (CVN 77).

Master Chief Mark is a graduate of the U.S. Navy Senior Enlisted Academy and Command Master Chief course.

His personal awards include the Meritorious Service Medal (two awards), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (four awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (seven awards), and various unit and campaign awards. He has earned the Enlisted Aviation and Information Dominance Warfare Specialist pins.
