Please **MUTE** your phones unless you are speaking to reduce background noise and be sure to **NEVER** place your phone on **HOLD** if you need to step away.

DCO Access

In order to prepare in advance, you **MUST** have a computer with an internet connection to be able to see the PowerPoint presentations that will be delivered through DCO. If you have used DCO on the computer being used for the meeting since DCO's recent update, you should be fine. If you have not, please download any updates.

Due to the fact that DCO is run within a government secured system, there are several security certificates that must be installed on your computer to be able to access DCO. If you get messages about certificates being bad or missing, you must add those to your computer before you will be able to connect. Whenever you are presented with the option to accept/continue/allow/install, etc., please do so. You may need anywhere from 2 or 3, but sometimes upwards of about 20 certificates depending on what you already have installed on your computer.

If the procedure above does not work, load this link in Internet Explorer and follow the on-screen directions-
