The Department of the Navy, Office of Civilian Human Resources, is soliciting civilian nominations for the Civilian Legislative (LEGIS) Fellows Program FY2013. LEGIS is open to Navy civilians who occupy a GS-13 and above or salary equivalent position.

The Navy Legislative Fellows Program provides a unique opportunity for Department of the NAVY (DON) civilians to broaden their understanding of the legislative process and the operation of Congress through a year-long full-time assignment to a Congressional member or to the professional staff of a Defense Oversight Committee. The Legislative Fellows Programs also enhances the Navy's ability to fulfill its role in the national policy development process. Potential fellows must have demonstrated sustained superior performance and potential for future assignments in critical billets.

The program is scheduled to begin 3 December 2012; however selectees must be available to report to Washington, DC no later than 5 November 2012 for a three week orientation. Additional information can be found on the NAVAIR Career Development COI:
