

NAVAIR, DECODED

Training conducted by the Defense Acquisition University (DAU) is aimed at the entire Department of Defense (DoD) acquisition workforce and leaves specifics to the System Command. How NAVAIR supports the acquisition of naval aviation systems, and how it is organized to do so, is highly complex and not easily understood. This course will teach students the role NAVAIR plays in providing solutions to gaps in Navy and Marine Corps warfighting capabilities. Students will learn how NAVAIR interfaces with the warfighter and the DoD budget to develop and deliver systems and services incorporating both new and mature technologies. Classroom discussion will focus on the NAVAIR competency-specific activities while emphasizing their personal role. Students will begin to understand and experience the organizational communication and coordination necessary to provide the broad range of services and technical expertise essential to providing, operating, and sustaining new weapon systems in the fleet.

NAVAIR leadership will reinforce learning objectives by directly supporting the class as commentators and guest speakers. There are a number of exercises throughout the course culminating with a senior leadership panel.

Pre-requisites (suggested, not required): ACQ101, CAO-IPT CONOPS

Audience: This course is open to all, however to receive maximum benefit from the course, participants are expected to meet these minimum experience levels:

- Entry Level: 3 - 5 years at NAVAIR
- Journey Level: 3 - 5 years at NAVAIR
- Military Personnel: 2 - 3 years at NAVAIR
