PROBLEM:

NAVICP 00-35T-37-4 TBA increase for W/C 670 (MMF's)

DISCUSSION:

The proposed TBA allowance reduction for MAL-16 V-22 Osprey footprint for Work Center 670 will negatively effect the maintenance efforts of the calibration work center. According to the projected TBA of MMF's for 670, the allowance for CL-07 (test equipment staging MMF) will be decreased from four (4) to three (3). Since the procedures for processing test equipment will remain constant. The current allowance for CL-07's is the absolute minimum required to safely stage and process test equipment which will be awaiting maintenance, awaiting production control approval and processing, awaiting parts and awaiting disposition/sub-custodian delivery.
