

MOBILE FACILITY PROGRAM REVIEW ACTION ITEM

PROBLEM: TOO MANY DATABASES TO UPDATE. THERE'S A NAVAIR DATABASE, A MARFOR DATABASE, A MAW DATABASE, AND FINALLY A MALS DATABASE. WHEN ONE CHANGES, ALL OTHERS NEED TO BE UPDATED CONTINUOUSLY. THIS CREATES CONFUSION GOING BOTH UP AND DOWN THE CHAIN.

RECOMMENDATION: MAKE THE NAVAIR DATABASE UNIVERSALLY ACCESSIBLE BY EACH MARFOR, MAW AND MALS. IF IT WERE TO BE KEPT ON THE MOBILE FACILITIES WEBPAGE AS A "READ-ONLY" FILE, THIS WOULD CUT OUT THE NEED FOR A CONTINUOUS UPDATE BY ALL LEVELS INVOLVED. LESS CONFUSION AND NO NEED FOR "BOUNCING" THE DATABASES DURING AN INSPECTION PERIOD. IT COULD ONLY BE UPDATED BY NAVAIR.
