ACTION ITEM NO.: 2-174

PROBLEM: Too many activities are required to manually track MF movement and inventories, often resulting in numerous inventory discrepancies and man hours lost trying to correct discrepancies.

RECOMMENDATION: Rather than maintain separate local inventories at the MALS, WING, NAVAIR, etc., create a web based inventory so that each activity is updated as changes occur. If a MALS tries to drop an MF from their inventory they must provide the unit the MF was shipped to, and the DTG of the shipping message before the drop will be allowed. The MF would then automatically show up on the new units inventory with a flag attached to it pending the DTG of the receipt message. MF movement should also be tracked in the SERMS system so if an MF is deployed, temp loaned, etc. it's physical location can found in a timely manner.

MARFORLANT comments: Concur with the basic premise. Current method of inventory maintenance results in numerous inconsistencies and unnecessary man (and woman)hours spent on annual inventory correcting discrepancies. Transfer/receipt messages are the primary means for making routine updates. Message traffic has proven to be a major stumbling block. A local working inventory should be maintained however, it would be more efficient to have a web based central inventory with limited access for making updates. The approving authority for a given action should be able to make the update as necessary. For instance, intra-wing movement should be updated by the wing MFC, inter-wing movement should be updated by the MARFOR MFC.
