**PROBLEM:** CNO ltr Ser N781/1U655596 of 10 Oct 2001, grants a deviation from compliance with OPNAV 4790.2H, Vol V, Chapter 14, paragraph 14.3f (3) and (4). This paragraph directed that all nonavionics SE and all AWSE be washed down every 28 days ashore. NAVAIR 13670 references the 4790 as the source document for complying with 28 day wash of MF's. There is now no existing source requirement for compliance with 28 day PM/wash.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Use this opportunity to determine if a 28 day cycle is the most efficient and effective use of manpower weighted against what is really required for effective preservation of MF assets. Once a baseline is established incorporate the requirements into NAVAIR 13670.
