PROBLEM: MF MARKINGS

DISCUSSION:

Program conflicts exists between Mobile Facilities (MF), Embark and IMRL as to the required markings and decals for each program. Due to the conflicts, Units are confused and often "doing, then undoing" markings for the sake of passing a particular program inspection or audit.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Standardize MF markings across the board. If necessary, bring other Program managers on-line to determine "how", if at all, their markings are to be incorporated. Follow up with a current NAVAIR Instruction, referencing the other Program Instructions and Orders.
