**PROBLEM:** Type Equipment Codes (TEC). With the overhaul of many Mobile Facilities the TECs have become very confusing especially to new Marines in 990. We have several frustrated Logbook and Inventory records (LIRs) simply because the conversion sheet does not identify specific part numbers and the LIRs has two different TECs entered.

**RECOMMENDATION:** We identify MFs mostly by configuration codes whenever we do anything. I propose that the MFP utilize the config codes as the TECs. It will eliminate frustrated Logbook and Inventory Records (LIRs), it will allow the LIRs to be in order via config code(the new TEC) order then serial number order as stated in the Marine Corps Order. The only con to this is the amount of work to have all MFs in Nalcomis and SESS changed to the new codes.

**STATUS:** CLOSED -TEC's are assigned IAW the NAMP, Vol III, Appendix K. Config Codes would not work in place of TECs.

- There are 10 known TECs for MF's.

- 7 are for MF's listed in AUTOSERD, 2 are for MF's not listed in AUTOSERD but TEC is Active, 1 is for MF not listed in AUTOSERD and the TEC was deleted (see list next slide)
