Command Master Chief (AW/SW/IDW) Scott McCreery grew up in Lexington Park, MD and graduated from Great Mills High School, Great Mills, MD, in May 1985. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in July 1989 and reported to Recruit Training Command Great Lakes, IL, where he completed Basic Training and Airman Apprenticeship Training.

He then reported to USS KITTY HAWK (CV 63) where he was promoted to Third Class Petty Officer and Second Class Petty Officer as an Aviation Boatswain's Mate (Handler). He completed two Western Pacific deployments and transferred in 1993.

Master Chief McCreery then reported to Navy Recruiting District, Philadelphia, PA and recruited in the Washington, D.C. metro area where he was selected as "Recruiter of the Year" for 1995. He promoted to First Class Petty Officer and transferred in 1996.

He reported to USS KEARSARGE (LHD 3) where he completed two Mediterranean deployments and earned the Enlisted Aviation Warfare Specialist and Enlisted Surface Warfare Specialist qualifications before transferring to Naval Station Rota, Spain, in 1998.

After completing his tour in Europe, Master Chief McCreery converted to the Navy Counselor (NC) rating and reported to USS YORKTOWN (CG 48), where he was selected to Chief Petty Officer. He completed two Counter Drug Operation deployments and one Persian Gulf deployment, earning the Officer of the Deck (Underway) qualification before decommissioning YORKTOWN in December 2004.

He then reported to the U.S. Naval Academy where he assisted in the training and mentoring of over 4000 Midshipmen and was promoted to Senior Chief Petty Officer.

In 2007, he reported to USS IWO JIMA (LHD 7), where he was accepted into the Command Senior Chief program. He departed IWO JIMA in September 2008 and attended the Senior Enlisted Academy and Command Master Chief/Chief of the Boat course in Newport, RI.

He reported for duty aboard USS ELROD (FFG 55) where he was promoted to Master Chief Petty Officer and served as the Command Master Chief.

After his frigate tour, Master Chief McCreery served as the Command Master Chief for the Helicopter Sea Combat Squadron TWO SIX (HSC-26) "Chargers" home ported in Naval Station, Norfolk, VA.

Master Chief McCreery reported as CMC aboard USS ESSEX (LHD 2) homeported in Sasebo, Japan in Dec 2011 and completed a hull swap with USS BONHOMME RICHARD (LHD 6) where he served as the Command Master Chief until Dec 2014.

He returned home in Dec 14 to serve as the Command Master Chief of Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division in Patuxent River, MD.

Master Chief McCreery's personal awards include: Meritorious Service Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (5), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (6), and several other personal and unit awards.
