NOTICE TO NAWCTSD  
MAC IDIQC Awardees  
FTSS III / TSC III / TDPC MAC

This letter serves to provide notice and reminder to all firms holding basic contracts under NAWCTSD's Multiple Award Contracts (MAC) TSC III, FTSS III and TDPC of the post award requirements for small business program re-representation. FAR clause 52.219-28 Post-Award Small Business Re-representation is incorporated in each of the NAWCTSD MACs. The clause requires contractors that represented their firms as a small business concern prior to award of their MAC basic contract, to re-represent their size status in accordance with specific criteria. Because these MACs are long-term contracts the re-representation requirements of 52.219-28 (b) (3) are applicable; within 60 to 120 days prior to the end of the fifth year of the contract; and within 60 to 120 days prior to the date specified in the contract for exercising any option thereafter. However, the re-representation requirements of FAR clause 52.219-28 are not limited to paragraph (b) (3) alone and paragraphs (b) (1) and (2) also apply:

- (1) Within 30 days after execution of a novation agreement or within 30 days after modification of the contract to include this clause, if novation agreement was executed prior to inclusion of this clause in the contract.
- (2) Within 30 days after a merger or acquisition that does not require a novation or within 30 days after modification of the contract to include this clause, if the merger or acquisition occurred prior to the inclusion of this clause in the contract.

The re-representation shall be made in accordance with FAR clause 52.219-28 paragraphs (c) and (e), where the contractor shall re-represent its size status in accordance with the size standard in effect at the time of the re-representation that corresponds to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code assigned to each contract. The contractor shall make the re-representation required by validating or updating all its representations in the Online Representations and Certification Application and its data in the Central Contractor Registration/System for Award Management as necessary, to ensure that they reflect the contractor's current status. The contractor is responsible for notifying the contracting office in writing within 30 days that the requirements of FAR clause 52.219-28 paragraph (b) have been met.

The sole purpose of this letter is to remind MAC awardees of their re-representation obligation pursuant to FAR clause 52.219-28. Specific MAC terms and conditions will dictate eligibility for future MAC participation as a prime, subsequent to the re-representation.
