



U.S. NAVY Mobile Apps

Sailor Self Service through a Bring Your Own Device Solution.



In response to the modern needs of the Department of the Navy (DON), the Sea Warrior Program (PMW 240) has built a process for the rapid development and deployment of mobile apps for the Navy. Apps allow the Navy to take advantage of mobile devices for Sailor self service functions. It increases the reach of training and information to Sailors, giving them more options to independently manage their careers. Apps currently deployed are designed to run on a Sailor's personal device and contain no sensitive information or Personally Identifiable Information (PII).

Apps increase the reach of training and information to Sailors.

APPS



eDIVO

Released: March 2015

eDIVO is a Navy mobile app developed to support Division Officers and other Navy leaders. The app provides quick access to 44 PDF manuals to Sailors on their phones/tablets (without internet connectivity) providing ready access to the information quickly while reducing reliance on informal and unreliable information.



Final Multiple Score (FMS) Calculator

Released: October 2015

This app calculates projected FMS for Navy enlisted Sailors, ranging from paygrades E3 through E6 looking to be advanced to paygrades E4 through E7. The FMS app calculates the advancement formula and contains a helpful tutorial for Sailors who are not familiar with how FMS elements are calculated as they navigate the Navy Enlisted Advancement System (NEAS).



New to the Navy

Released: November 2015

The New to the Navy app is designed for those Sailors (Enlisted and Officers) fresh out of Boot Camp or Officer Candidate School and their family members. Content is designed specifically to help answer common questions new Sailors may have as they launch their careers with the U.S. Navy.



Navy COOL

Released: January 2016

Navy COOL offers major elements of the Navy's Credentialing Opportunities On-Line (COOL) website in a convenient app. The app is essentially a toolbox – or 'COOLbox' – that provides Sailors and others with a set of credentialing and career tools that help them make informed professional development decisions throughout the continuum of their Navy career and beyond.



LifeSkills
Released: April 2016

LifeSkills provides information and resources to Sailors and their families to give a better understanding of Navy policy and guidance. LifeSkills is a face-to-face course delivered after recruit training and prior to the start of technical training, and content for the app is intended to both reinforce classroom delivery and provide additional information.



Pregnancy and Parenthood
Released: June 2016

The Pregnancy and Parenthood app informs service members of pregnancy and parenthood related policies and resources. Policy information includes topics such as planning, physical readiness, maternity uniforms, adoption, leave, operational deferment, parental rights and responsibilities, and more.

TRAINING APPS

Training apps allow users to fulfill the Navy's General Military Training (GMT) requirements. Once training is completed, users can document completion of their training requirements in the Electronic Training Jacket (ETJ) using their DODID number. End-of-course completions can be emailed to Navy Training Management and Planning System (NTMPS) for display in the Electronic Training Jacket (ETJ).



Domestic Violence Prevention (DVP)
Released: September 2015

The DVP app is a mobile training and resource tool that provides easy access to domestic violence prevention information and training. It is a mobile version of the Domestic Violence Prevention GMT course.



Naval OPSEC
Released: November 2015

The OPSEC app is an all-in-one Operations Security reference, training, and education tool for Navy personnel and their family members. This app consolidates all relevant Navy OPSEC information into one easy-to-use application, including "Uncle Sam's OPSEC" (USOPSEC) GMT video-based course.



Records Management
Released: April 2016

The Records Management app provides training for all DON personnel (military and civilian) and provides general recordkeeping methods/responsibilities to assist in eliminating use of hardcopy records and encouraging electronic records. Training ensures compliance with Records Management Program governed by 44 U.S.C. 3301.



Personally Identifiable Information (PII)
Released: April 2016

The PII app is a training and resource tool that provides easy access to PII training to increase privacy awareness and improve the safeguarding of personal information. It is a mobile version of the PII GMT course and includes a separate refresher training modules that can be taken by those causing a PII breach.

eSAILOR APPS

The eSailor series of mobile apps was initiated at the direction of the Master Chief Petty Officer of the Navy. eSailor leverages state-of-the-art mobile technologies to transform training and enhance curriculum delivery methodologies at Recruit Training Command.



US Military Ranks & Reference
Released: June 2016

The U.S. Military Ranks and Reference app provides a score based and sortable reference area to review different rank insignia across the Military Services.



Ships and Aircraft Training
Released: June 2016

The Ships and Aircraft Training app provides an interactive flashcard style app to educate on the visual identification of over 100 naval ships, aircraft and equipment complete with facts and trivia questions.
