CMDCM (SS) RANDY J. HUCKABA COMMAND MASTER CHIEF, NAWS CHINA LAKE

Master Chief Huckaba, a native of St. Louis, MO. enlisted in the Navy in April of 1985. He has attended the following courses of instruction: Basic Training in Great Lakes, Ill; Basic Enlisted Submarine School Groton, CT; Instructor Training School. Kings Bay, GA; Senior Enlisted Academy and Chief of the Boat/Command Master Chief Capstone Course, Newport, RI.

He reported as Command Master Chief to Naval Air Warfare Center Weapons Division, China Lake California in October 2014 and was previously the Command Master Chief for Naval Submarine Base, Kings bay Georgia. Previous sea duty
