DoD Mentor-Protégé Program



PL 101-510 sec 831; DFARS 219.71 and Appendix 1

Provides incentives for DoD contractors to assist small businesses in enhancing their capabilities, and to increase participation of such firms in Government and commercial contracts

- Proposals accepted quarterly for evaluation
- Agreements endorsed by NAVAIR & DoN; approved by DoD OSBP
 - Typically 1-3 years
 - Mentor identifies costs for Protégé development (technical & business areas)
 - Two types of Agreements:
 - 1) Mentor receives credit towards SDB goal based on identified costs; or
 - 2) Mentor receives reimbursement for development costs
- Funding provided by DoD through NAVSUP; max \$1M/year
- Bi-yearly reporting of status to us & DCMA
- FY09 Mentor-Protégé Conference in March
- Several NAVAIR Agreements won the annual DoD Nunn-Perry Award





NAVAIR MENTOR-PROTEGE AGREEMENTS



- Bell Helicopter Textron / ACT Aerospace – Supports H-1 and V-22
 - Started in FY07
- Raytheon / Tampa Brass & Aluminum – Supported Tactical Tomahawk & AMRAAM
 - Completed successfully in August, 2008
- Raytheon / ENSER Corporation – Supported AIM-9X
 - Completed successfully in July, 2008
- Boeing / Pioneer – Supported F/A-18, T-45 and C-130
 - Completed in May, 2008
- Lockheed-Martin / Aegisound - Supports JSF and PMA202
 - Started in May, 2008
- Raytheon / UEC – Supports AIM-9X and AMRAAM
 - Started in October, 2008
