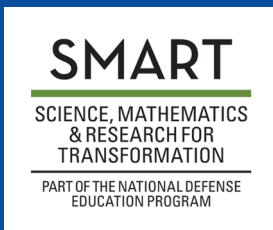
Enrolled students (BS, MS) 31+ credits

Program Information

- 10-week summer opportunities
- Stipends: \$7,000 for new undergraduate student participants; \$8,500 for returning undergraduate students; and \$11,000 for graduate students pursuing a graduate degree

Eligibility Requirements

- U.S. citizen
- Any student who:
 - Graduated high school (or equivalent) and,
 - Currently has 31 or more college credits, and,
 - Is enrolled at an accredited four-year U.S. college or university

Application Period:

Enrolled students (BS, MS, PhD) 18+ years old

Program Information

- Full tuition and education-related fees (does not include meal plans, housing or parking)
- Stipend of \$25,000 - \$38,000 depending on degree being pursued
- Summer research internships
- Health insurance allowance of up to \$1,200 per calendar year
- Miscellaneous supplies allowance of \$1,000 per academic year
- Employment at a Department of Defense facility after graduation

Eligibility Requirements

- U.S. citizen
- Able to participate in summer internships at a Department of Defense facility
- Willing to accept post-graduate employment with the Department of Defense
